About the San Quentin correspondent of "The People", you were misinformed. Warden Hale of San Quentin Prison writes me that said prisoner has been sentenced for a term of eight years under four separate commitments. The maximum penalty for vagrancy in this State is imprisonment in the County jail for one year. We have not yet reached such barbarism as to mete out such penalties for vagrancy. San Quentin is within sight of this city and it is not so pleasant for those who contemplate joining our Party to think that that gloomy Bastille is bursting with future accessions to our Party. We have too many who should deservedly be there strutting

in and around our organization.
