Dear comrade,

Yours in relation to the New Constitution of Section San Francisco received, and I will bring the matter before the next meeting of the State Ex. The fickle mindedness of the average man is very discouraging to one who is guided by fixed principles. This very Section that in January voted almost unanimsly that no members should hold two offices, in March elected by "an overwhelming majority" a member of the State Ex committee to the office of city organizer! in direct opposition to the law they had enacted two months before.

It was reported to the last meeting of the State Ex. that the National organizer would visit the Pacific Coast during this summer, and I was instructed to find out the particulars if true, in order that we might make necessary arrangements.

Section San Jose has unanimously voted to surrender its present charter and request one covering Santa Clara County. This Section is one of our best and I think there is no objection to granting the request, as it is the only Section in the County.

Harriman as you will see in the Class Struggle is doing good work in the field, and I hope we will be able to keep him on the road all the year. He is the best debater I ever met, and if he succeeded in getting his opponents to face him on the platform at San Bernardino last Tuesday it was a sorry day for them.
