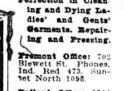

The report of the National Secretariat on the annual report of the National Committee affords splendid food for thought for the Revolutionary as well as for the Opportunist Socialist and especially for the members of the N. E. C.

The comparisons here are based on the estimates of the population in the various states as contained in the World Almanac for 1938. These estimates credit Washington with a population of 306,000, while the entire country is given 88,912,000.

Table showing membership statistics for various states like New York, California, Illinois, Pennsylvania, etc.

It is interesting to know what the membership would be in the states with 1,000 or more members if the same ratio between membership and population prevailed in those states as in the state of Washington.

It will be seen that the Eastern States with their numerous industrial centers, all have an insignificant membership when compared with Washington.

Perhaps after all, the "narrow," "sectarian," "dogmatic" and "impossibilist" cry of "Proletarian" and "Revolutionary" is a little more than wind. Perhaps the American Worker after all has as much confidence in the Proletarian organizers in the State of Washington as in Rev. Carl D. Thompson, Rev. Harvey De Brown and Rev. Winfield Gayford of Wisconsin.

It would be a good plan for him to use part of the time now occupied in studying Esperanto, for investigating the subject of organization.
